# A few reminders...

## School Uniform

A reminder that on PE days when Y5 and Y6 come to school in their PE kits, they need to ensure they follow the school uniform policy. Our PE kit is black shorts or joggers, white t-shirt, black sweatshirt and black pumps or all black trainers. We are increasingly getting children with labelled/named tops and shoes. PE Is only a part of the day and parents and children are expected to follow the school uniform policy.

## Traffic outside school

The parking situation is becoming poor again. It is for the safety of parents and children that drivers need to adhere to parking rules around the roads of Ridgeway. Please do not park on both sides of Main Road as this causes a bottle neck and traffic cannot flow through the village. Please use the parking around the Memorial Field. I know it is busy at drop off and pick up times but we all need to be courteous to others to keep everyone safe.

### Homework

We believe in the importance of trying to balance the need for homework and the fact that children need time to relax, attend clubs and be kids! The tasks set should take children between 15—30 mins. depending on age.

- EYFS —reading (10mins x 4 times per week) and 1 additional task (this will start later this term)
- Y1 & 2—reading (10mins x 4 times per week), spellings, times tables and 1 additional task.
- Y3 & 4—reading (15mins x 4 times per week), spellings, times tables and 2 additional tasks.
- Y5 & 6—reading (20mins x 4 times per week), spellings, times tables and 2 additional tasks.

## Flu Vaccine 2021

Dear Parents/Carers,

For the school year starting September 2021 we will be continuing with the e-consent for the Flu Programme. This year we will be offering the Nasal Flu vaccination to children in **Reception**, **Year 1**, **2**, **3**, **4**, **5**, **and 6**. The option to consent or decline the vaccination is at the end of the questionnaire so please complete even if you do not want your child to have the vaccination.

If you wish to decline the Flu spray due to the porcine element we are now able to offer an alternative injectable Flu vaccine that does not contain porcine. Please complete the consent form as a decline due to vaccine ingredients and we will then contact you to arrange vaccination. For more information please contact the team as below.
