### Covid 19 News

The rules on testing and isolation seem to be changing regularly at the moment so it's hard for us to give definite guidance. The key things for school are that If your child seems unwell, keep them off school and use a lateral flow test. If the test comes back positive, isolate according to the current government guidelines and inform school.

If you are not sure what to do, please ring the school and we will talk you through the current guidance.

We are working hard in school to create a safe environment for the children and staff so we appreciate your support in trying to reduce the spread of the virus.

#### What to do if your child is off after testing positive for Covid 19 and is well enough to do school work.

On each class remote learning page, there is a list of daily activities for children to complete on their remote learning page of the school website. These include online platforms the children are using regularly in school eg Bug Club for Key Stage 1 reading, Times Table Rockstars for key Stage 2 maths. Pupils should complete as many of the activities as possible each day. They can let their teacher know which activities they have completed through using Seesaw.

If the class teacher is setting more work then they will indicate this by asking you to log onto Seesaw where the work will have been allocated. If you need any help with this, please email the class teacher (all addresses are on the main class page)
